# **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- 1. DOWL update: Beacon angle was adjusted on the morning of Thursday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, to 10 degrees from the current 5 degrees, to address community complaints about the obtrusiveness of the new beacon LED lights. AWOS project completion is still waiting for FCC to confirm the frequency. Once the FCC signs off, installation of the AWOS unit should take 3-4 days of on-site work. Retired FAA representative Karen Miles' official replacement is Thomas Richards, who is already in place and familiar with Lopez airport from a previous visit last year. Finally, Wes and Megan of DOWL will assist the Port with the WSDOT FAA grant use survey, as they have necessary vendor/subcontractor information.
- Pump-out boat: Boat operator from last year will return to run the pump-out boat service again this year. Season will likely run from June to the end of September.
- 3. Cell Tower: T-Mobile will have a crane on-site to service/install equipment on the tower mid-April, exact date still TBD.
- 4. Stidham/Nickel Bros home move: Initial conversations suggest that a likely path would involve entry through the North gate, via the Channel Rd. improved

accessway, and exit through the South gate. Next step will be a visit by Nickel Brothers and the homeowner to evaluate options. Move to most likely take place in 2026.
